Rescheduling for the Seven Spectacular Days of Summer Events

Dear Parents,

Following on from my letter to you yesterday, I am now in a position to inform you that the child who tested positive on two LFD tests yesterday has now tested positive following a PCR test. As we expected, the academic year finishes now for the children. Staff will not be planning any lessons for next Monday or Tuesday as both days, as you know, were always planned as off timetable, fun days. I hope that the children can enjoy these extra days of the summer holiday playing in their gardens and having fun, albeit whilst isolating. School staff will be continuing to work from home and the office staff and are still in school working so any questions can be answered through phoning or emailing.

Please keep me informed if any of your children test positive for Covid throughout the summer holidays.

I am determined that we will hold the fun events that we had planned for the rest of our Seven Spectacular Days of Summer in School. To this end I attach the revised plans. You can see that the activities are taking place over the first three days of the new academic year from Thursday 2nd September to Monday 6th September. Our current Year Six children (Year 7s) are invited to attend the three evening events – the Leaver's Service, the Camp Night and the Leavers' Disco.

Sports Day

On Thursday 2nd September, the first day of school for the children, everyone needs to attend school dressed in their PE kits. During the afternoon we will be having the sports day that was planned for yesterday. Sorry, at this point in time, we are not inviting any parents to attend this event. Unfortunately the Year 7 children will not be able to attend the event as they will be attending their new secondary schools.

Leavers' Service

On Thursday 2nd September we would like all of the school children from Years 1 to 6 (current Year R – Year 5) in our school to stay after school for the Leaver's Service. Teachers will be providing some fun activities to engage in straight after school and children will be provided with a drink and snack. The Leaver's Service will then begin at 4pm. The newly elected Headboy and Headgirl will be announced at this service. If your child is unable to attend this after school event then please email me to let me know. School will therefore finish for everyone at 5pm on this day.

Year 7 children coming back need to wear their new School Uniforms – if secondary schools will not allow your children to finish school early to attend this service then do contact me and I will contact the schools directly. At this event only parents that ordered tickets from our Year 7 cohort will be able to attend. The event will take place on the school field.

Camp Night

This event is going ahead exactly as it was planned but on Friday 3rd September. Children may come to school dressed in their own clothes and we will have an amazing evening together, with you collecting your children at 10:30pm. I will assume that the children who have already signed up for the event will attend on this night.

Year 7 children are invited back for this event. If the children cannot attend from 3pm please email me directly to inform me what time they will arrive.

Leavers' Disco

From 6pm – 8pm on Monday 6th September we will be holding the Leavers' disco. We very much hope that all of the Year 7 children will return to attend this prestigious event. All children are expected to dress smartly for this event. Again I am going to assume that all of the children already signed up for this event will be attending it. Please let me know if this is not the case for your child.

Play Leaders/Buddies Day

This is now going to take place during the school day on Wednesday 22nd September. Children may wear their own clothes to school on that day.

SO, hopefully everyone will attend these events and our Summer Spectacular will straddle the summer holidays.

I will write one final letter to you next week with details of what our school will look like in September given the Step Four of our roadmap will be in place by then and the fact that isolation rules are all changing on 16th August.
