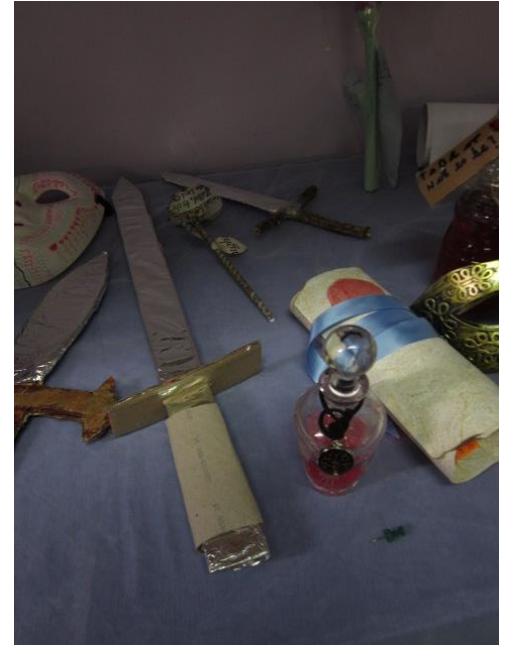
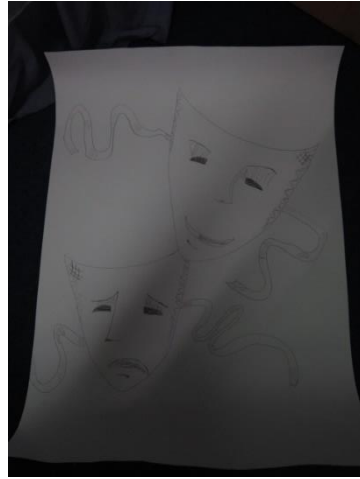
Welcome to Squirrels Class!

This term, our topic is 'Shakespeare' and we have been reading the text Romeo and Juliet. Look at all of the incredible creations we have made for our topic table!





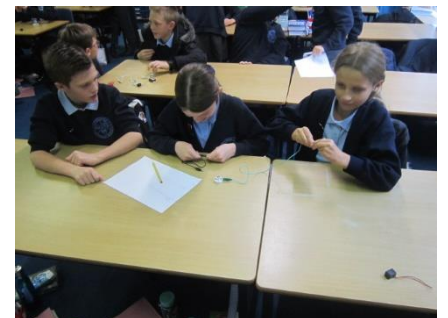
Last term, we were lucky enough to experience cooking with 'Roots to Food' again. We worked in our teams to create a delicious and nutritious meal while developing key skills.
