Subject	Overview
English	We will begin our new writing unit on writing fact files about magical sea creatures.
Maths	Year 3 will be adding and subtracting. Year 4 will be calculating with Roman numerals and negative numbers.
RE	We answer the question: Can I make links between the story of Noah and how we live in school and the wider world?
PSHE	We will learn to manage when there are set-backs, learn from mistakes and reframe unhelpful thinking
ICT	We will recognise the parts of a computer.
PE	We will hopscotch forward and backwards, alternating legs after each hop.
DT	We will investigate and analyse a range of existing products (pulleys, levers, sliders)
Geography	We will explain the way the clouds and rain are formed and also consider the elements of a river.
