
Hedgehogs Class

In Year 1, we have been using manipulatives to help us understand number bonds to 10, and to compare more or less.

In Year 2, we have used manipulatives to help us understand how to compare numbers, and to help us to learn our related facts.



In English, we have been using drama to help us to understand the characters' thoughts and feelings. In pairs, we each took it in turns to act in role of the main character of our book, as well as an interviewer asking questions about the character's choices.

This gave us a deeper understanding of our book and allowed us to think outside the box in our lessons.
