<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will finish publishing our family description, whilst also moving onto our next focus book – "On the way home" by Jill Murphy. *Please send a family photo in if you have not already done so 😊 Deadline is Wednesday*
Maths	Year 1s are going to be finding, learning and comparing number bonds to ten. They will be using their new knowledge of parts and wholes as well as fact families to help them with this. Year 2s are going to be starting our new topic on Addition and Subtraction. We will be starting by comparing number sentences, learning fact families for number bonds to 20 and checking our calculations.
Science	We will be having an end of unit assessment about what we now know about light.
Geography	We are going to be defining what physical geographical features are as well as giving examples.
History	We will be having our end of unit assessment on what we now know about what Victorian homes were like.
RE	We will be reflecting on our knowledge of what Christians believe God is like and exploring the importance of forgiveness for Christians.
Computing	We will be identifying what information could be public and what should be kept private.
PE	We are continuing to develop our ability to balance on one leg. We are playing mini-games and warm-ups that allow our balancing skills to improve.
