THIS WEEK's LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will be describing the features of a pirate and following instructions.
Maths	Year 1 will be recognising coins and notes and counting in coins. Year 2 will be learning about how to tell the time (including o'clock, half past and quarter past/to).
PE	Hedgehogs will be working on balancing floor work by holding and maintaining a mini-front position. Hedgehogs will be competing in some competitive sports - please wear PE kits on Wednesday.
PSHE	Children will looking at how people and animals need to be looked after and cared for.
