<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>	
Maths	<u>Year 5 learning focus:</u> start of unit assessment numbers to 10,000 rounding to 10, 100 and 1000 numbers to 100,000	<u>Year 6 learning focus:</u> start of unit assessment numbers to 100,000 numbers to 1 million numbers to 10 million
English	We will begin reading our topic text "Cosmic". The children will use inference skills to predict what the text is about, learn to empathise with key characters and generate suitable vocabulary linked with the text.
