<u>Subject</u>	Overview
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be working together to build bridges We will be discussing why might the troll not want the goats to cross the bridge? Y1- We will discuss the rules and regulations that help keep us safe.
Communication and Language	We will be learning the rhyme-London Bridge is Falling Down Using language small, medium sized, big related to the goats Hot seating as the characters from the story
Physical Development	Jasmine PE ball skills, a golf lesson and PE with Mr Lopez Y1- Children will begin individually moving a ball in different routes around their body. They will then get into pairs and find different routes for passing the ball in and out and around each other's body.
