### THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	To talk about and recognise different emotions. We will be discussing emotions linked to our Drawing club text "The Colour Monster".
Communication and Language	Learning new poems from the Poetry basket. Talking about the different emotions and when we have felt them and how we dealt with them.
Physical Development	BEAM programme, Squiggle while you Wiggle, Dough disco and PE with Coach Julie. We will also be doing lots of Funky finger activities linked to our phonics, such as pegging and finger printing.
Literacy	Drawing club this week we are reading "The Colour Monster". We will be making marks and writing the initial sounds of words to do with our story and thinking of codes to use in our drawings. <b>Y1 We will be using capital letters and full stops, identifying adjectives and using adjectives.</b>
Maths	We will be comparing size, mass and capacity in many different ways. <b>Y1 will be completing our Place Value unit and beginning our Addition and Subtraction unit, introducing parts and wholes and the part-whole model.</b>
Understanding the World	RE- <b>Why is the word 'God' special to Christians?- Why do Christians need to look after the world?</b>  (Woodlands) Outdoor Explorers- To know that deciduous trees lose their leaves in the Autumn.  We will be learning about our senses and exploring them all this week. We will be using all of our senses with a variety of exciting activities!
Expressive Arts and Design	Music- We will be exploring and learning how to use some percussion instruments. Listening and following instructions on when to use them. Art- We will be looking at the Artist Alma Thomas and her use of colour. We will be learning how to use the paintbrush to create a similar effect,
