THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	To talk about what we already know about our community and who they have met before. Sharing what we would like to do when we are older and why.
Communication and Language	Learning new poems from the Poetry basket. Asking our visitors questions.
Physical Development	BEAM programme, Squiggle while you Wiggle, Dough disco and PE with Coach Julie. We will also be doing lots of Funky finger activities linked to our phonics, such as hand printing, bouncing balls and folding paper to make fans.
Literacy	Drawing club this week we are reading "Supertato". We will be making marks and writing the initial sounds of words to do with our story and thinking of codes to use in our drawings. Y1 Writing a caption to go with their drawing of what they would like to be when they are older.
Maths	We will be exploring simple patterns and then learning to repeat them and creating our own. Y1 will be learning about bonds within 10, systematic number bonds within 10 and number bonds to 10.
Understanding the World	RE- Why is the word 'God' special to Christians? What can we do to look after our world? This week we are learning about our community and the people who help us. We have a Nurse, Midwife and a Police Officer coming to talk to the children about their line of work.
