### THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be reading the traditional tale "The Little Red Hen". We will be exploring the theme of sharing and should the Little Red Hen have shared the bread?
Communication and Language	Learning new poems from the Poetry basket. We will be learning and using new vocabulary linked to the theme of Autumn and Harvest.
Physical Development	BEAM programme, Squiggle while you Wiggle, Dough disco and PE with Coach Julie. We will also be building up our muscles kneading dough to make bread.
Literacy	Drawing club this week we are reading "The Little Red Hen". We will be making marks and writing the initial sounds of words to do with our story and thinking of codes to use in our drawings. Y1 will be writing sentences to caption their drawing club ideas.
Maths	We will be finding numbers 1,2,3, subitising (Instant recall) 1,2,3, representing 1,2,3 and finding one more and one less. Y1 will be learning about number bonds to 10, adding together and adding more.
Understanding the World	RE- Why is the word 'God' special to Christians? <i>What can we do to look after our world?</i> We will be exploring signs of Autumn. We will also be making bread linked to our literacy text "The Little Red Hen"
Expressive Arts and Design	This week we will be looking at how to make a model in DT. Children will be drawing out a plan of what they would like to make and talk about the features and what they will need. Then they will create their model to take home. In Music we will continue our learning about Exploring sounds. This week we will finish with Nature sounds
