THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be talking about who is scared of the dark? Why? How could we make the little owl feel better? We will be describing the different feelings.
Communication and Language	Poetry basket- Who has seen the wind? We will be retelling the story of Owl babies, using props and learning new vocabulary from the story such as nocturnal and diurnal. We will be reflecting on our trip from Eagle Heights and talking about our experiences.
Physical Development	We will be making playdough owls. Snipping paper to make feathers and feeding the pretend owls with tweezers
Literacy	Drawing club- Owl Babies New vocabulary- Owl, Owlet, Evening, Swooped, Cavity, Prey
Maths	We will be looking at the composition of 1-5. Identifying and naming shapes with 4 sides. Combining shapes with 4 sides and looking shapes in the environment.
Understanding the World	We will be identifying different owls. Which animals are nocturnal? Use battery powered devices and explore light sources. RE- Which bible stories tell Tom and Tessa that they are precious to God?
Expressive Arts and Design	We will be creating Collage owls. Acting out the story with instruments. Making leaf owl cage. Colour mixing- painting owls Creating our own version of Starry Night By Vincent Van Gogh- mixed media art We will be exploring Hanukkah Music in our Music lesson.
