<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
	This week we will-
<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b>	<p>Thinking about the feelings of the baby owls in the story. Have we ever felt like this?</p> <p>Reading 'The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark'- Are you afraid of the dark?</p> <p>Taking part in our first school trip!</p>
