THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be learning about how to be a safe and sensible pedestrian. We will be discussing how we can work and play cooperatively with each other and take turns when playing a variety of games.
Communication and Language	Poetry basket- Hungry Birdies Talking about train journeys we have been on. Sharing photos and discussing the journeys and what we did and saw.
Physical Development	In our PE lessons we will be practising our throwing and catching skills. Learning the basics of catching the ball.
Literacy	Drawing club- Wacky Races (Animation) New vocabulary- Accelerate, braking, hazard, steering, chuckle, demolish, overtake, transport What can we see out of the train window- imaginary train journey
Maths	We will be working on comparing mass, finding a balance and exploring and comparing capacity.
Understanding the world	RE- What message did Jesus bring? We will be comparing pictures of transport from now and from the past
Expressive Arts and Design	In Music as part of our unit of exploring sound, we are focussing on instrumental sounds. We will be using instruments to accompany the rhythm of the story. We will be making paper collage trains to practise our scissor skills and using chalk and charcoal for smoke and learning how to create different effects.
