THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be discussing the story of Mr Gumpy's outing and discussing the different emotions in the story.
Communication and Language	Poetry basket- Popcorn We will be retelling the story of Mr Gumpy's Outing using puppets. We will also be talking about how we can help others.
Physical Development	In our PE lessons we will be focussing on catching a ball. We will be using different equipment such as scissors, tape dispensers and staplers to create our own boats to test in water.
Literacy	Drawing club- Mr Gumpy's Outing New vocabulary- Courteous, Overboard, Drenched, Kind-hearted, Generous, Farewell We will be retelling the story of Mr Gumpy's outing using the puppet characters.
Maths	We will be working on the numbers 6,7 and 8. We will be finding them and representing them in different way. Please encourage your children to spot numbers in the environment. Please share with us in Seesaw where you have seen them! We will also be revisiting 1 more and 1 less than a number.
Understanding the world	RE- What message did Jesus bring? We will be exploring how objects move in water. We will also be investigating floating and sinking.
Expressive Arts and Design	In Music as part of our unit of exploring sound, we are focussing on Environmental Sounds. We will be making and floating boats and exploring watercolours in our sketchbooks.
