<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	Talking about how different families celebrate Christmas. Y1s We will describe different features about family life, including what families do / enjoy together.
Communication and Language	Re telling the Nativity Story using small world toys.
Physical Development	Wrapping presents. Exploring Christmas Scents in playdough.
	Y1 In a seated balance position, children will transfer equipment from a hoop on one side of their body to a hoop on the other side. They must only use their feet.
Literacy	Writing letters to Father Christmas. Labelling toys and gifts and writing Christmas cards. Year 1s will be writing letters to Santa and continuing their work on fact files on nocturnal animals.
Maths	Christmas Themed maths focusing on numbers to 5 finishing one less than a number, Christmas Maths games and activities.
