<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	Talking about sharing, related to the story of the Little Red Hen.
Communication and Language	Learning and using harvest/Autumn vocabulary. Retelling the story of LRH in order
Physical Development	Listening to instructions to join in with simple games.

Maths	Comparing amounts, height and length. <b>Y1 will be learning about less than, greater than and equal to, as well as using this vocabulary to compare numbers.</b>
