<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
	This week we will-
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	* Learn about different families and that not all families look the same.
Communication and Language	*Practice rhyme and alliteration using the nursery rhymes- Hickory Dickory Dock and Hey Diddle Diddle *Talk about our families and use photos to introduce our friends to our family.
Physical Development	*Practice different balances and movements to show control and coordination. *Use scissors to practice snipping and cutting along simple lines. *Start our fine motor morning rotation each morning.
