### THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will continue writing our retell of Jack and the Beanstalk. We have been working on writing in the past tense and using conjunctions in our writing.
Maths	Year 1 children will continue working with number bonds to and within 20. Year 2 will start a new topic: statistics and data handling.
Science	In science this week we will be exploring the idea that animals, and humans, have basic needs to survive. We will identify the most important needs of animals and research how we can help support the needs of our pets and animals around us.
Art	We will be drawing upon our discussions in RE to design the front cover of The Nativity program.
Geography	In geography this week we will be exploring the impact of fieldwork and how we can use it to answer our big question this term - is plant life supported within our school grounds?
Music	This term we will be using our afternoon sessions to apply our cross curricular skills in art, DT, music, drama and English to practice the Nativity.
