THIS WEEK'S LEARNING:

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will be describing a character and writing a postcard to the old baker lady in the role of The Gingerbread Man.
Maths	Year 1 will be finding and making number bonds to 20, learning about doubles and understanding near doubles. Year 2 will be counting the faces, edges and vertices on 3D shapes.
Science	We will identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
PE	We will continue our 'Dance' unit in PE, We are going to be developing our dance routine to the song 'I Just Can't Wait to be King', adding section 5 of our routine.
RE	We will answer the question: 'Is the good news taught by Jesus just for Christians?'
