THIS WEEK'S LEARNING: ASSESSMENT WEEK

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will be starting to read 'Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs', making predictions and discussing characters.
Maths	Year 1 will be comparing mass, discussing full and empty, comparing volume and measuring capacity. Year 2 will be multiplying and dividing by 10, learning the 5 and 10 times tables, and consolidating their Multiplication and Division unit.
Science	The class will find out about why day length is affected by the seasons and investigate weather during the seasons.
PE	We will be learning to dribble a ball in Hockey with Miss Rawlings. In a seated balance position children will work in pairs and create shapes with their bodies, their partner must copy their shape as accurately as possible with Miss Richardson.
RE	We will be assessing what we know about why Easter matters to Christians.
PSHE	Hedgehogs are going to consider how to keep money safe and the different ways of doing this.
Computing	We will make careful choices when adding/changing text.
Music	Hedgehogs will use timbre and dynamics in musical composition.
