In Term 6, our Topic will be The Great Fire of London. We will begin the term briefly focussing on the book 'The Wooly Bear Caterpillar' and writing an explanation on how caterpillars change. We will then move to the book 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London', where our writing outcome will be to write a recount of the fire in the role of a character.

Phonics

Children will have

Phonics lessons every day as usual. They will continue to develop their knowledge of different grapheme-phoneme correspondences and we will be applying them in other lessons. If they are part of the Little Wandle reading groups, they are expected to read their book at home after three reads of the book in school.

Geography

We will be exploring weather and climate. We will be discussing how we can record and measure different weather phenomena. We will also continue to discuss our local park.



Maths



This term in maths, Year 1 will be learning about:

- Position and Direction

- > Time

History

During our Great Fire of London Topic, we will be exploring how the Great Fire changed London, how London was



eventually rebuilt, and what impact it has had on

fire safety.



Science

Our focus for the term is Plants: Name and Structure. We will be looking at the names and structure of different plants, describing and comparing these.



Music

We are focusing on two different



themes this term. The first is 'On this Island', where we will be looking into traditional British songs. The second is 'Traditional Western Stories', where we will learn about orchestral instruments.

PSHE

Our topics during the Summer terms will be "Who helps to keep us safe?" and "How can we look after each other and the world?". These topics will help give us an insight as to who has a duty to protect us in society, and also help us to understand the importance of our own role in protecting the planet and what we can do to help it.

PE

During Term 5 and 6, our focus in PE will be on building our cognitive skills.

In Term 5 we will work on our dynamic balance through balancing on a line.

In Term 6 we are going to work on our static balance.

We will also learn about Netball and Tennis in this time.


