<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will be publishing our diary entries in the role of Beegu and looking at our next writing outcome: a fact file of space.
Maths	Year 1 will be going over key concepts from Addition and Subtraction and beginning their unit on Geometry. Year 2 will be securing their understanding of adding and subtracting when crossing 10, as well as looking at mixed addition and subtraction problems.
PE	In groups of 3, children will pass each other a range of equipment using a mixture of working with their hands and their feet.
RE	We will give examples of how Christians use the nativity story to influence their lives today.
