Term 3



Phonics

Children will have

Phonics lessons every day as usual. They will continue to develop their knowledge of different grapheme-phoneme correspondences and we will be applying them in other lessons. If they are part of the Little Wandle reading groups, they are expected to read their book at home after three reads of the book in school.

RE

We will be covering the religion of Christianity in the Spring Terms, understanding the unit 'Gospel' in RE in Term 3, and 'Salvation' in Term 4.

Maths


<u>Year 1</u> -

This term in maths, Year 1 will be learning about addition and subtraction within 20, as well as place value within 50. They will also be learning about measurement of lengths, heights, weights, and volumes. They will be using a lot of manipulatives to support their learning.

Year 2 -

For the spring terms in Year 2, maths will consist of multiplication and division. As well as this, Year 2 will be learning about statistics, properties of shapes and fractions. Year 2 will also be using manipulatives to support their learning.

History





Geography

We will be exploring our local park.



Science

Our focus for the term is Animals including Humans. We will be naming animals and body parts, explaining what they are for. We will also be looking into the work of Amy Vedder, an ecologist who is famous for her work in setting up a conservation for critically endangered animals.



Music

We are focusing on two different



themes this term. The first is 'Superheroes', which looks at pitch and tempo. The second is 'Musical Me' where we will explore melody, dynamics, timbre and simple notation.

PSHE

Our topics during the Spring terms will be "What helps is stay healthy?" and "What can we do with money?" These topics will allow us to investigate real life problems that people face every day, and educates us on how we can keep ourselves happy and healthy through our diets, the activities we take part in, and the hobbies we engage in.

PE

During Term 3 and 4, our focus in PE will be on building our social skills.

In Term 3 we will work on our dynamic balance and agility through jumping and landing.

In Term 4 we are going to work on our static/seated balance. We will also learn about Dance and Hockey in this time.

In Term 4, our Art unit is 'How have artists been inspired by castles?'. We will be designing, sculpting (using clay) and painting our own sculptures of castles.

For this term in computing, we will be learning about creating media through digital painting in Term 3, and digital writing in Term 4.
