Monitoring Worship


In Term 3, we worked alongside our Headteacher, Miss Bridges, and our Chair of Governors, Mrs Cole, to monitor worship across the school. After an initial meeting, we each observed a worship to identify key strengths and areas for development. In Term 4, we will share our findings at a feedback meeting which can then be passed on to the staff. This will allow us to further strengthen collective worship each day.

Leading Worship

Each Friday, we have been leading worship alongside Miss Hurdle to spread the word of God and share our Christian Vision. We have been using different forms of storytelling, including role play, to teach about each of our Christian Values and the Bible stories which accompany them. We work together to encourage the children of Fawkham to apply our Christian Values within their everyday lives and to recognise Jesus' sacrifice as he came to Earth so that we could life in all of its fullness. Throughout the week, we gather pupil voice to ensure children have understood the message and have the opportunity to share their thoughts and reflections. These are then added to our Leading Lights display board.

Weekly Meetings

Every week, we meet with Miss Hurdle and Mr Banks to evaluate our action plan and consider new ideas for engaging children in worship and in spreading the word of God. In December, Miss Hurdle attended a training course about children leading worship. Since then, we have been learning how to lead worship effectively including the different elements, such as: gathering, engaging, responding and sending.
